Categories

- 3. Sculpture (clay, stone, metal, ceramic)

Prizes

The top four entries in each category will receive cash prizes as follows: 1st \$500, 2nd \$300, 3rd \$150, and 4th \$100. One entry will be awarded an additional \$150 for "Best of Show."

The schools with the most Top-3 winners will receive the following for their art program: 1st \$500, 2nd \$350, 3rd \$250, 4th \$100. Total prizes awarded in this contest are \$4,500!

Submitted artwork must be original. Entries are judged on creativity, craftsmanship, composition, and interpretation of the theme. Each piece must include an artist's statement and the title of the work. No late entries.
